**Voir Dire** = French for "to speak truth." It is a preliminary examination of a witness or a juror by a judge or counsel. *Voir dire* is an important part of the jury selection process. During *voir dire*, prospective jurors are asked a series of questions to determine whether or not they are fit to serve on the jury. .May also be called "jury examination" or "jury selection."

Getting to Know Jurors:

- -Get jurors talking
- -Ask open-ended questions
- -Determine the impact of experiences
- -Ask about jurors' opinions
- -Listen to jurors
- -Pay attention to body language
- -Use juror questionnaires
